



Instructions for Authors

Journal Ratarstvo i povrtarstvo is a diamond open access journal included in DOAJ and SCOPUS. Articles are distributed under the terms and conditions of the Creative Commons Attribution (<u>CC BY</u>) license. There are no submission charges or article processing charges (APC). The peer-review process is double-blind and voluntary. Submitted manuscripts are checked for plagiarism using iThenticate. All editorial processes follow the guidelines of international regulating bodies and best practices in academic publishing.

The journal publishes previously unpublished review articles, original research articles, and preliminary reports, as well as preprints. The scope of the journal includes the following: genetic resources, genetics and breeding, biotechnology, microbiology, agro-chemistry, agro-ecology, plant physiology and biochemistry, seed production and processing, growing and cultivation practices, plant protection and agro-economics of field crops, vegetables and medicinal plants. Articles are published in three annual issues in English with abstracts in Serbian.

Online submission

Manuscripts are submitted via <u>Aseestant</u> publishing platform. Authors' names and affiliations are entered online during the submission process.

Manuscript text and language

The manuscript should be prepared in Microsoft Word, font Times New Roman, font size 12 and single line spacing. It should not exceed 10 pages. Summary should contain 250 words. Author names and affiliations should not be listed in the manuscript. List up to ten key words alphabetically.

The journal publishes articles in English. Both British and American variant are equally accepted and authors choose their preference. The preferred variant must be consistently used throughout one manuscript. Summary in Serbian is provided by the editors. Italicize the names of species in Latin and foreign words and use standardized abbreviations and SI units.

Graphics

Designate all graphics as either Tables or Figures and number them in the order in which they appear. All graphics should be put into their appropriate place within the manuscript and referred to in the text. If a table or figure is taken from another publication, cite the source publication and provide permission from the copyright holder(s) when submitting your manuscript. Table titles and figure captions should be concise and informative. Display and explain data in graphics in such a manner that they are clear and understandable separate from the text. Provide unit measures, legends, and bar scale on maps, and explain any abbreviations and special symbols. All images must be of high quality.

References

The journal uses <u>APA Citation Style</u> (7th Edition). References are listed in the original language as published. For information purposes, an English translation of the title should be provided in brackets next to the original title. Titles and names written in a non-Latin script (e.g. Cyrillic) should be transcribed or transliterated into the English alphabet. The reference list should contain only works cited in the manuscript. Provide doi for all references where possible.

Author statements

Once the manuscript is accepted for publication, the corresponding author will provide additional information as follows: valid ORCID IDs for all authors, contributor roles according to CRediT taxonomy, name anyone who contributed to the research or the writing of the article but who does not qualify as an author in the Acknowledgements section, state any competing interests and ethical issues (including use of AI tools), state data availability and funding. In addition to these statements, corresponding author must also provide statement of authorship signed by all authors and permissions to include the name and affiliation from all those mentioned in the Acknowledgments section.
